

"For meritorious and efficient performance of duty as an aerial gunner attached to a Marine torpedo bombing squadron operating in the Solomon Islands and Bismarck Archipelago areas from July 20, 1943 to March 2, 1944. During three tours of duty, Staff Sergeant HAISLIP participated in thirty-one bombing and strafing attacks against Japanese installations, frequently being subjected to intense anti-aircraft fire and heavy fighter plane opposition. His courage and accurate marksmanship contributed materially to the defense of the plane on all missions and were in keeping with the highest traditions of the naval service."
